

Privacy Policy

Welcome to the website of Langowski Logistics Corp. (hereinafter referred to as “Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”). This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, store, and protect the personal information of users of our website Langowski.com (hereinafter referred to as “Website”). Our goal is to provide full transparency regarding data processing and to comply with applicable laws, including the Florida Information Protection Act (FIPA) and other relevant regulations.

1. What Information Do We Collect?

When you use our Website, we may collect the following types of information:

a) Information Provided by You

- Contact Information: Name, email address, phone number, and other details you provide through contact forms, service requests, or communications with us.
- Business Information: Information about your company, such as its name, address, and tax identification number, when using our freight forwarding services.

b) Information Collected Automatically

- Technical Information: IP address, browser type, operating system, device information, and location data (based on IP address).
- Usage Information: Information about how you use the Website, such as pages visited, time spent on the Website, and links clicked, collected through analytics tools (e.g., Google Analytics).

c) Cookies

Our Website uses cookies and similar technologies to enhance user experience, analyze traffic, and personalize content. For more information, please refer to our Cookie Policy (#).

2. How Do We Use Your Information?

We collect and process information for the following purposes:

- Service Provision: To respond to inquiries, prepare offers, and provide freight forwarding services.
- Communication: To contact you regarding your inquiries, services, or updates.
- Analysis and Improvement: To analyze Website traffic, improve functionality, and tailor content to user needs.





- Legal Compliance: To fulfill legal obligations, including those related to tax, accounting, or data protection regulations.

3. Legal Basis for Processing Information

We process personal information based on the following legal grounds:

- Consent: When you have given consent to process your information, such as when subscribing to a newsletter or filling out a contact form.
- Contract: When processing is necessary to perform freight forwarding services or prepare an offer.
- Legal Obligation: When we are required to process information under applicable laws, such as for tax purposes.
- Legitimate Interest: When processing is necessary for our legitimate interests, such as Website traffic analysis, provided it does not override your rights and freedoms.

4. Who Do We Share Your Information With?

We do not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. However, we may share information in the following circumstances:

- Service Providers: We work with trusted partners who assist us in providing services, such as hosting providers, analytics providers (e.g., Google Analytics), or CRM systems.
- Public Authorities: We may disclose information if required by law or in response to a legitimate request from law enforcement agencies.
- Carriers and Logistics Partners: To provide freight forwarding services, we may share information with logistics partners when necessary to fulfill a service request.

5. How Do We Protect Your Information?

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, alteration, or disclosure. These measures include, but are not limited to:

- Data encryption (e.g., SSL/TLS protocol on the Website).
- Restricting access to information to authorized personnel only.
- Regular updates to software and security systems.

In accordance with the Florida Information Protection Act (FIPA), in the event of a data security breach, we will promptly notify the appropriate authorities and affected individuals if there is a risk of harm to their rights.

6. How Long Do We Retain Your Information?



We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable laws. For example:

- Contact information from forms is retained for the time needed to respond or provide services.
- Analytics data is retained for the period specified in the settings of analytics tools (e.g., Google Analytics).
- Information related to freight forwarding services is retained for the period required by law, such as for tax or accounting purposes.

7. Your Rights

Under applicable laws, including the Florida Information Protection Act (FIPA), you have the following rights:

- Right to Access: You may request information about the data we process.
- Right to Rectification: You may correct inaccurate or incomplete information.
- Right to Erasure: You may request the deletion of your information if there is no legal basis for its continued processing.
- Right to Restrict Processing: You may request the restriction of processing in certain circumstances.
- Right to Object: You may object to the processing of your information based on legitimate interests.
- Right to Data Portability: You may request the transfer of your information in a structured format.
